The General Handyman may be asked to perform general carpentry, electrical, painting, and plumbing work and install new fixtures, equipment, and appliances as needed. They are also responsible for helping with the preventative maintenance program, handling guest requests and other work orders as assigned in a safe and efficient manner ensuring that the campground buildings, facilities, and grounds are well maintained and fully operational.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS

- Basic knowledge of carpentry, electrical and plumbing
- Ability to work nights, weekends and holidays
- Capable of working independently and as part of a team

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds, lift and carry 25 pounds occasionally and 10 pounds regularly.
- Move, lift, carry, push, pull and place objects weighing less than or equal to 10 pounds without assistance.
- Must be able to operate various loud and vibrating maintenance tools and equipment
- Ability to stand for long periods of time.
- Ability to bend, stoop, kneel, crouch, climb and move safely over uneven terrain.
