You will receive an RV site including water and a 30-amp hookup, free Wi-Fi and free laundry – we do not have FHU sites for work campers, but a honey wagon service is located on site and included in your stay.

We request 20 hours of volunteer work each per 4-day shift (5 hours each per day), in exchange for your site. Additional hours during busier times and weekends will be paid at \$14 per hour per person up to a maximum of 20 hours per week per couple.

**Requirements:** You must have your own good condition RV for accommodation onsite. Honesty, a friendly demeanor, and good customer service skills are essential. You must be capable of working well on a team, relating and working well with others, enforcing our rules, and addressing problem campers in a calm, respectful manner. You must have the ability to work independently, to accept guidance, direction and supervision and must pass a background check. Men and women who are jack-of-all-trades types are welcomed with open arms. You must be a self-starter with good organizational skills, be in good health and have excellent communication skills. You will be required to supply a criminal background check and references.

**Duties may include:** Cleaning washrooms, checking campers in, answering the phone, taking reservations, delivering ice/firewood, operating the honey wagon, nighttime security / quiet-time patrols to enforce our rules, grounds work, lawn and gardening, general maintenance, cleaning restrooms, etc.

Downtown Halifax is a short drive or a 30-minute bus ride from the campground. Major stores such as Costco, Walmart, Canadian Tire, etc. are a 10 minute walk away and there are great beaches and hiking/biking trails nearby for your enjoyment. We are right on the Shubenacadie river, so bring your canoe or kayaks.

Preference will be given to a couple with previous campground and/or customer service experience, and an up-to-date police check statement. Preference will also be given to those who have computer, CRM and POS skills and the ability to operate lawn-care machinery. This position is especially suitable for a retired couple with previous experience as campground hosts or work campers. If you can't attend an interview in person, we'll have a video chat.
